Don't forget to do this as we won't know how hard you have been working.

We are wanting to keep the Stream aspect of Google Classroom for general questions and communications from the teacher. We are concerned that these will get lost with the vast quantities of work that is being sent - (which is wonderful!)

We realise that due to parents work commitments that not all work can be submitted during school hours. We appreciate your patience for feedback if work is submitted out of school hours - the teachers will respond when back on line and not live teaching.
