Dear Parents and Children,

Young Voices 2022

It's not long to go now before the big night and we hope all the children are looking forward to it as much as we are.

Tickets for the audience are being distributed today along with the t-shirts. At the concert, remember to look out for our school banner and give us a wave!

There are a few arrangements for the day. Firstly, the children will all need a packed tea. If your child normally has a packed lunch and you would prefer them to have a hot meal on this day at lunchtime, **please pre-order a meal on the Hutchison Appetite website**. Otherwise, they will require two pack ups - 1 for lunch, which they will have in school before we leave, the second we will take with us and eat after the practice and before the concert. Please ensure both are in plastic bags (label one lunch and one tea if they are bringing two because they are not having a hot meal) so that we can dispose of any rubbish easily and not leave boxes in school overnight. The usual healthy options apply and can I remind you that **no** fizzy drinks are allowed. It would be advisable to have a named bottle of water for your child to have access to during the concert, as they could get thirsty.

In addition to their t-shirt, can I ask that all children wear black trousers or leggings on the Thursday, sensible and comfortable footwear (but not trainers). They should also have their school jumper and a coat as it will be chilly leaving the arena at night. We would suggest that they **DO NOT** bring hats, scarves and gloves – we will not be outside for long and it will save them losing them.

We will be having an early lunch and leaving straight after in order to arrive at the Arena for around 1:30 pm. The children will be practicing during the afternoon and, having had their tea, will be seated and ready for the concert at 6pm. Parents are allowed to arrive at the venue from 6pm and the concert starts at 7pm (please be aware there are extra security measures in place so remember to allow extra time for this). You are strongly advised to check the arenas website to make sure you are aware of any new regulations in place.

At the end of the concert, approximately 9:15pm, the audience / parents will leave and then the children return to their coach in order to return to school. Children will be travelling back on the coach with the staff and we will meet you back at school. Please ensure you are at the school promptly ready and waiting for the coach to arrive (please do not return home expecting that the coach will be delayed – it is a long enough day for both the children and staff). As it will be dark and hard to see people, please ensure that the adult knows you are there and that an adult knows you are taking your child.

I hope I have remembered to cover everything, but if you do have any questions just pop into school and we will try to answer them. For ease of checking, please see the list below to ensure you have everything.

Checklist

- Pre-order a hot meal for your child before 9 am, 26th April 2022
- Children who are not having a hot meal at lunchtime - Pack up in a bag marked **LUNCH** – please put child's name on it too.
- Pack up for **TEA** in a bag marked **TEA** – again please put name on it.
- T shirts to be worn in the morning with black trousers and comfortable shoes. Please wear your school jumper.
- A coat – named
- A drink of water – named

Please ensure that if your child suffers with asthma they have an in-date inhaler pump with them on that day to take with them.
